









DS620A AND DS820A PHOTO PRINTERS: HOW TO TROUBLESHOOT USING THE INDICATOR LIGHTS

Overview

The LED lights on the front of the printer indicate the status. The lights can be on, off, or blinking. The combination of the lights indicates if there is a problem and exactly what the problem is.




State of Indicator	Error Message	Most Probable Solution
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turn on the printer. • Reseat power cord in socket and printer. • Plug power cord into different socket. • Check power cable for defects. • Try a different power cable.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	Not communicating with the computer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reseat USB cable in printer and computer. • Check USB cable to defects. • Plug into a different USB 2.0 port on computer. • Try a different USB 2.0 cable.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	Head cool down	The print heads are being cooled. This error is cleared automatically.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	No error	Printer is working properly.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	Out of ribbon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace media (ribbon and paper). • If already replaced, reseal ribbon properly. See page 14 of the DS620A User's Manual. • Slide the drawer shut until it locks.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> POWER RIBBON PAPER ERROR 	Ribbon error	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reseat the ribbon correctly. See page 14 of the DS620A User's Manual. • Slide the drawer shut until it locks.





State of Indicator	Error Message	Most Probable Solution
	Out of paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replace media (ribbon and paper). If already replaced, reseal paper properly. See page 14 of the DS620A User's Manual. Slide the drawer shut until it locks.
	There is something in the paper path that needs to be cleared.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visually check the paper path for debris and remove anything found. See DS40-80-620_HowToClearPaperPath.docx.
	Paper end	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reseal the paper properly or load a new roll. See page 14 of the DS620A User's Manual. Slide the drawer shut until it locks.
	Door is open. (No Paper)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slide the drawer shut until it locks.
	Media mismatch (Ribbon and paper lights blink alternately.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ribbon in the printer doesn't match the print job sent. Change the media or the size of the print job.
	Scrap box missing (DS820 series only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set the scrap box in the printer.
	Cutter jam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check for paper jam at the cutter. See DS_Clearing_A_Cutter_Jam.pdf. <p style="text-align: center;">Caution: Sharp components.</p>
	System error	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reboot the printer. (Turn off, then on.) If this condition is immediate when powering up the printer, it is a system error. Contact DNP Support to arrange for repair.




Reset Power Cord in Printer and Socket





Try Different Socket



Check Power Cord for Defects




Reset USB Cable in Printer and Computer
