**The following OS versions and processor architectures are supported:**

#### **Mac OS 10.6 (Snow Leopard):**

all executable modules should be 32/64-bit Intel binaries & support

-  Intel 32-bit processor architecture (i386)
-  Intel 64-bit processor architecture (x86\_64)

#### **Mac OS 10.5 (Leopard):**

all executable modules should be 32/64-bit Universal binaries & support

-  PPC 32-bit processor architecture
-  Intel 32-bit processor architecture (i386)
-  PPC 64-bit processor architecture
-  Intel 64-bit processor architecture (x86\_64)

#### **Mac OS 10.4 (Tiger):**

all executable modules should be 32-bit Universal binaries & support

-  PPC 32-bit processor architecture
-  Intel 32-bit processor architecture (i386)

## Purpose

This document includes instructions for installing the printer drivers for DS40/80 printers on Mac OS X.



### Attention

#### Before You Begin:

If the DS printer is connected to your computer, make sure it is turned OFF.

Go to **System Preferences > Print & Fax**. If a DS series printer is listed, delete it.

1. Insert the DS Printer Drivers installation disc into the disc drive of the computer.
2. A CD icon will appear on the desktop. Double-click the CD icon.
3. A window will open. Double-click the **DNP Install.dmg** file.

4. In the next window, double-click the **DNP DS Printer Drivers** icon.

5. The installer will begin. Click **Continue**.

6. Read the important information on the following screen. When you are done, click **Continue**.

7. Read the License Agreement on the following screen. When you are done, click **Continue**.




Figure 53. License Agreement

8. You will be prompted to accept the license agreement terms. Click **Agree**.




Figure 54. Agree

9. In the next window, click **Install**.

10. If your Mac operating system is password protected, enter your password when prompted. Click **OK**.

11. The installation will begin.

- When the installation is complete you will receive the message "Install Succeeded." Click **Close**.

You have now installed the DS Printer Drivers on a Mac operating system.

## TURNING ON THE PRINTER

- If the printer is not already plugged into the USB port, do so now.
- Turn the printer ON.
- The printer should be added as a device automatically in about 1 minute.



### Attention

Do NOT use the + sign to add the printer. In this case, you may have another instance of the DS Series printer in the printer list.

## TROUBLESHOOTING:

- Make sure the printer is connected to the USB port and turned ON. The LEDs on the printer should indicate a "Ready" status. (For more information on this, consult the DS Printer User Manual.)
- If the printer is added, but you cannot print:
  - Turn the printer OFF. Go to **System Preferences > Print & Fax** and delete any DS Printers listed.
  - Turn the printer ON and wait for the printer to add itself as a device.

If the printer does not automatically add itself to the printer list, use the + sign to add it in the **System Preferences > Print & Fax** dialog box.
